Content

- Interesting topic sentence effectively introduces the subject
- Ideas placed in a logical order.
- Transitions used appropriately.
- Focused on the subject. (paragraph unity)
- Clearly explains subject.
- Uses effective vocabulary and clear language.
- Uses grammatically correct sentences.

Delivery

- Speaks at an appropriate volume.
- Speaks at an appropriate speed.
- Enunciates clearly and pronounces words correctly.
- Uses inflection to convey importance of main points and enthusiasm for topic.
- Addresses audience and makes eye contact.
- Uses gestures appropriately.
- Maintains good posture.
